


### RELATIONALITY



### PLACE IN THE WORLD

- World is complex and interdependent.
   Disciplinary boundaries are blurred.
- · How do you fit into this world?
- Matching passion to the economy



#### **CRUEL OPTIMISM**

"A relation of cruel optimism exists when something you desire is actually an obstacle to your flourishing."

- Attachments to unachievable fantasies of the good life – upward mobility, job security, durable relationships, political and social equality – despite the rapid changes to our society.
- Doing what everyone is doing but expecting a different result.



### TOUR VS MAP KNOWLEDGE

- Tour (or topographical) knowledge operational, recognize directions of another, take prearranged route and vague understanding of final destination.
- Map (or topological) knowledge see the bigger picture, familiar with territory, sense of direction, knowledge of nodes & pathways to desired destination, awareness of alternative routes. Explorers and cartographers.

### **CONNECT THE DOTS**

- Life rarely follows a logical or linear progression.
- Passions will form from intersections of unlikely interests and capacities.
- Carving out unique path and combination.

You can't connect the dots looking forward; you can only connect them looking backwards. So you have to trust that the dots will somehow connect in your future.

### RENEWAL AND CHANGE


- Not like there's something inherent that is waiting to be unlocked. There is no perfect path.
- Turning points or epiphanies.

### OUR PERSONAL LIFE NARRATIVES

- Stories (either fictional or non-fictional) are a way to make sense of the world.
- Passion is a story. Need to learn the vocabulary and how to tell your personal story to others and more importantly yourself. Be a storyteller of your value.
- · Invites dialogue and self-reflection.
- Agency and communion with others.

- Part of the process of change
- A sign you are shifting to a new paradigm
- Letting go before you are forced to let go
- The beautiful idea that we can sacrifice the present for the future
